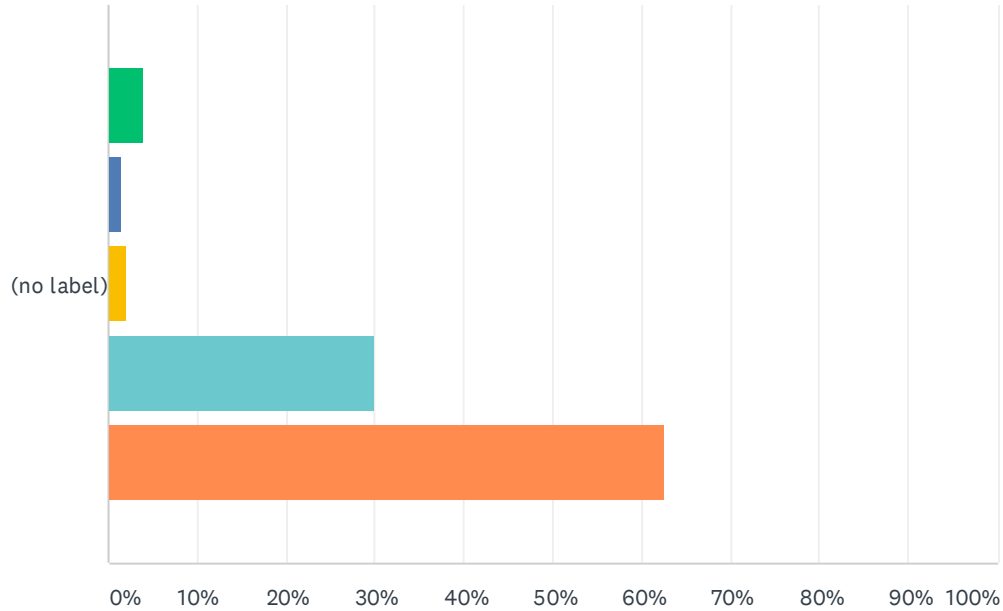


Q1 Overall, how satisfied were you with the overall application process?

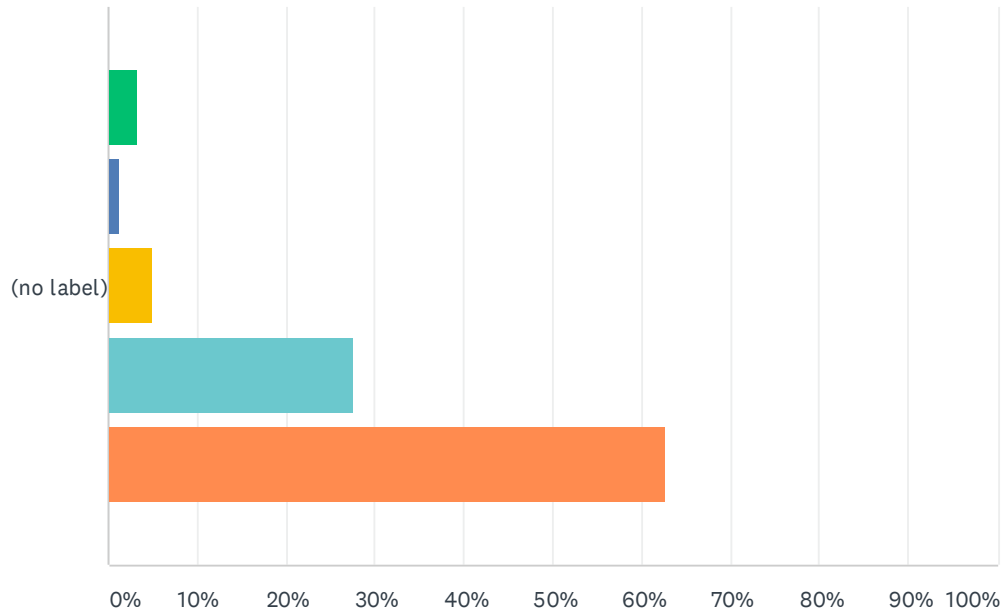

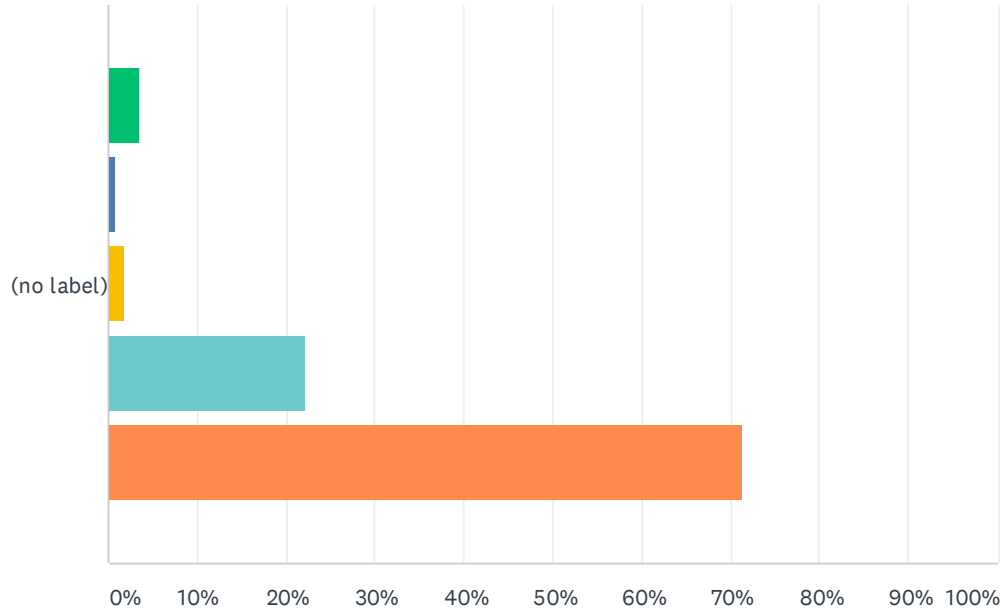

Q8 If current trends continued, how much longer do you expect your business could avoid permanent closure?

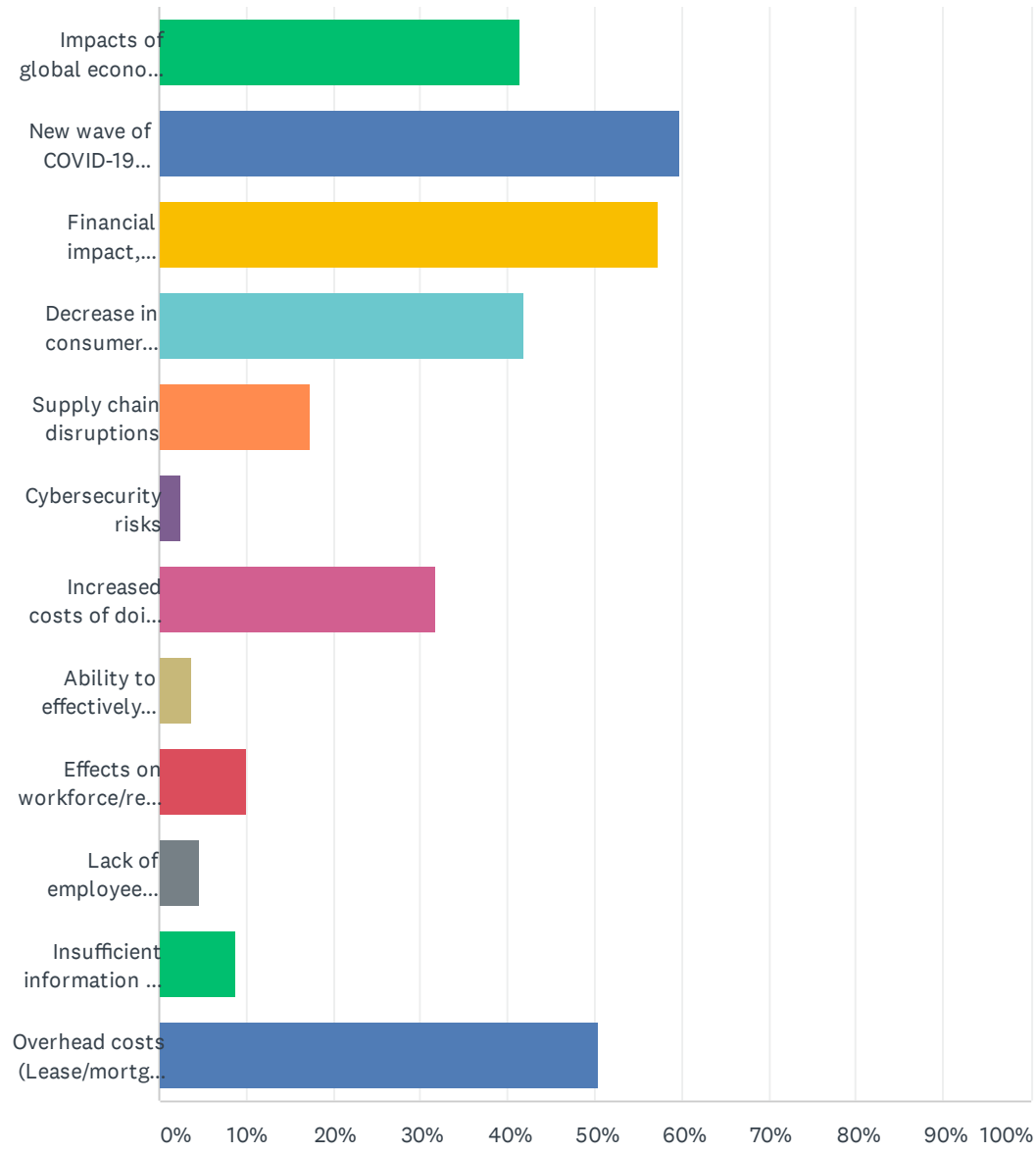

Q9 What are your top-three concerns with respect to returning to the workplace and/or operating in a changed business environment? (select top three)

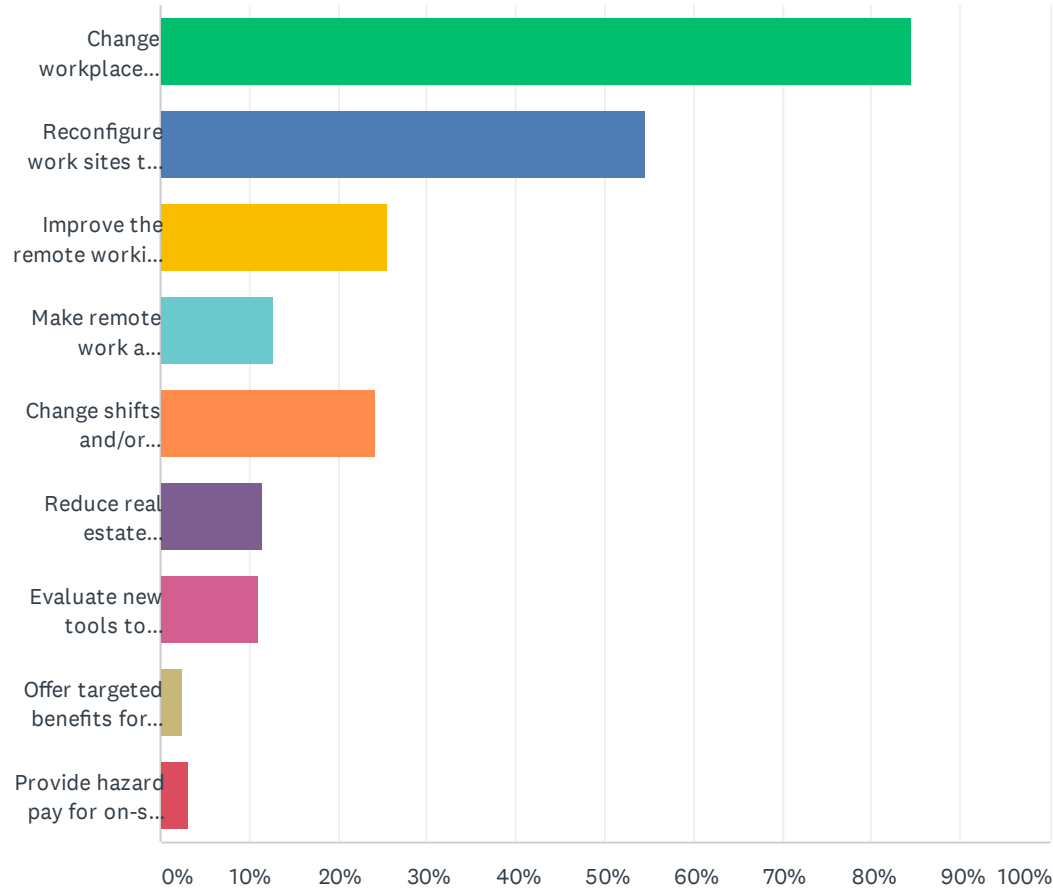

Q10 Which of the following is your business planning to implement (or has already implemented) once returned to on-site work? Please select all that apply.

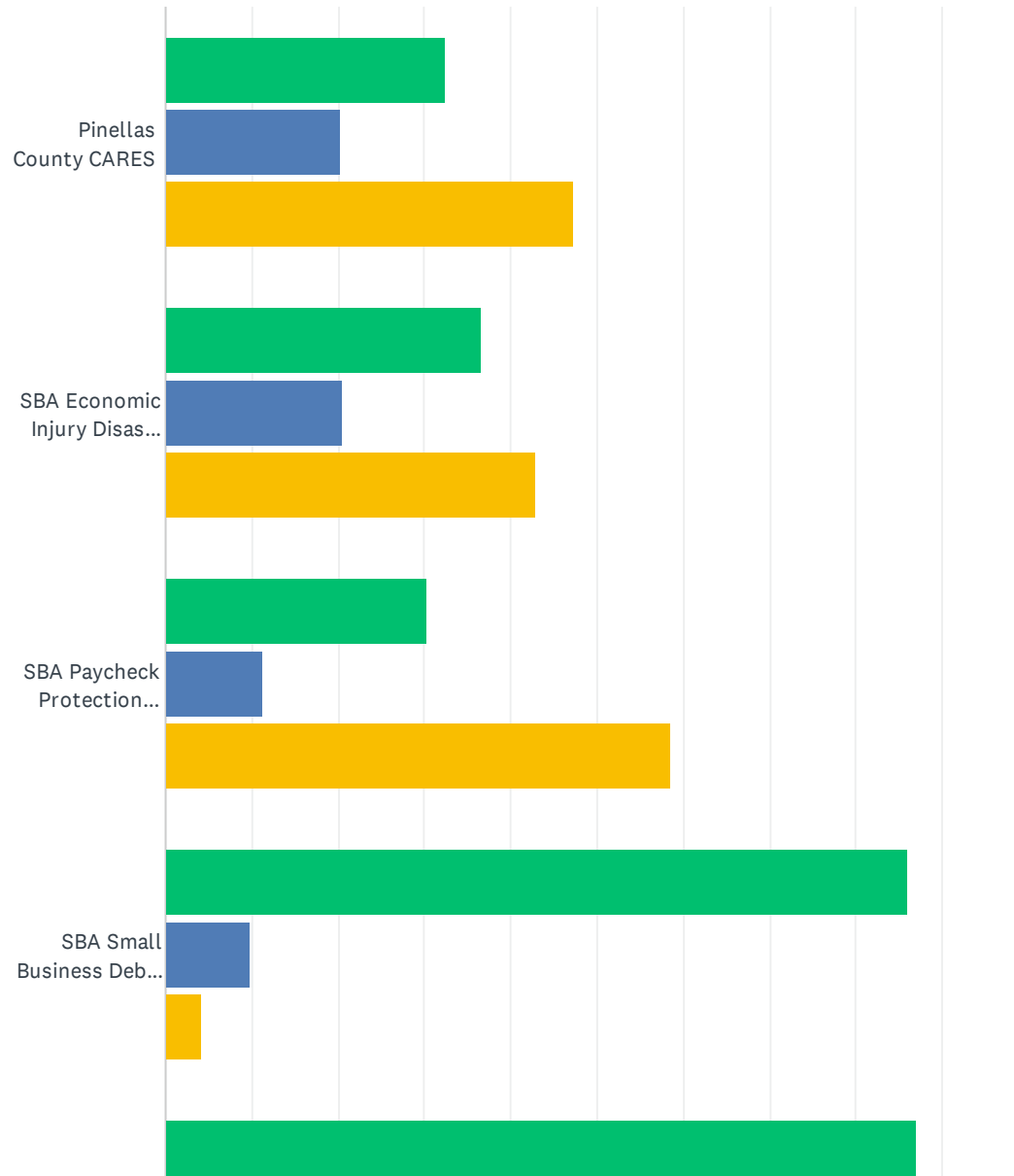

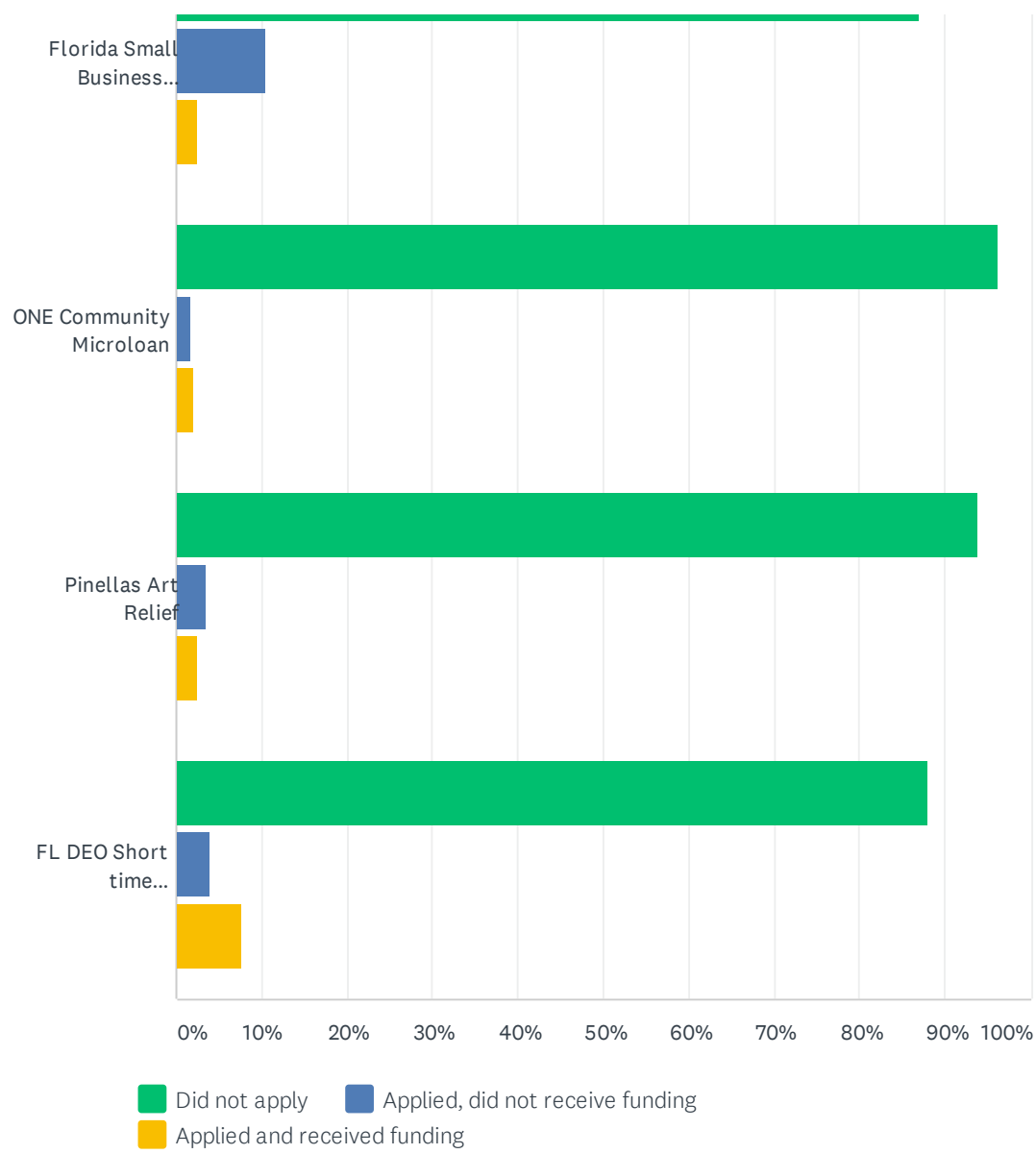

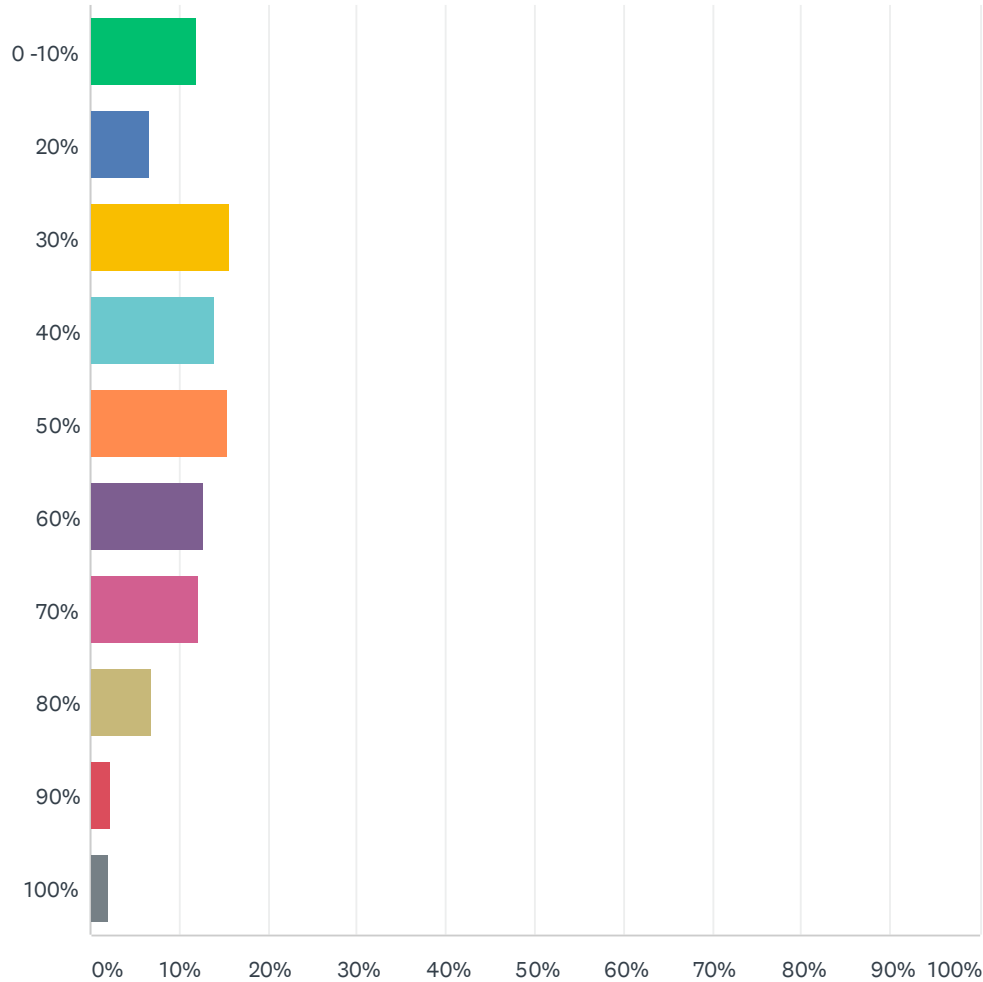

Q12 During the current reopening phase, what percentage of revenue is your business experiencing compared to average revenue prior to COVID?

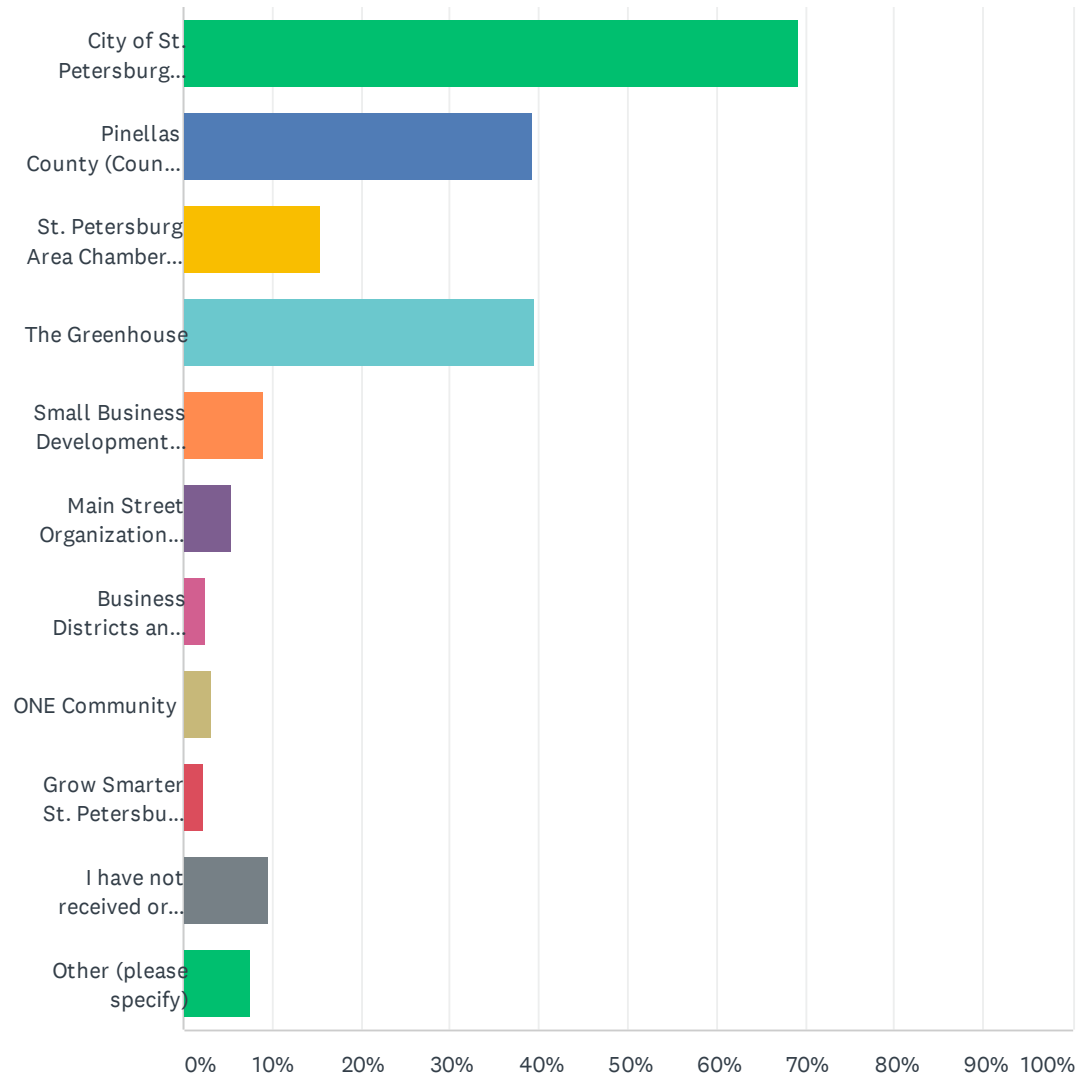
